Great Things Happening!

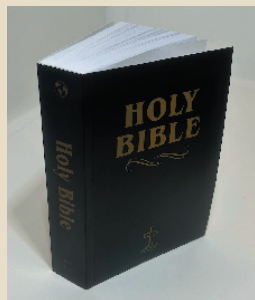
