Eternal Hell

Rightly Dividing The Word: Shelf 5 — Volume 49

Once we sort out our understanding of time in reference to the endless existence in which God dwells and is, then it is time to study again the concept of “eternal” hell. This god subsequently retires from the presence of the saints in heaven, and then goes over to check out the burning of those who have been cast into this “eternal” hell. God is thus fiendish, taking pleasure in the endless torment of sinners. If you believe in this kind of god, then you need to download and read diligently **Volume 49**.
